Monday June 12, the Cranbury Township Committee is hearing a presentation by the new owners of the 400-acre wooded parcel of land just north of Brick Yard Road. The new owners have proposed building 2.8 million square feet of warehouses on this land of forest, wetlands, and streams. On Monday, they are to report on the clean-up of the site. The Stony Brook-Millstone Watershed Association will be at the meeting to monitor the company's plans.

This site is one of the most important remaining undeveloped tracts left in Cranbury Township. The proposed development could harm sensitive wildlife habitats, pollute the nearby Millstone River, and add more truck traffic to the already dangerous Cranbury circle.

The clean-up and any eventual development that occurs on this land should be done in a way that protects its environmental values. If you agree, please attend the meeting or send us an email telling us you're interested. We'll send you back our assessment of the plan and how you can be involved.
